I am writing with great concern about the fate of Cherry Lane Cemetery, Hillingdon, should the Third Runway at Heathrow Airport be built. I have relatives buried there and I am worried that the expansion plans will include a road being passed through the cemetery. If this happens, it will certainly mean my loved ones will be disinterred and the distress this will cause my family and me would be intolerable.
